A READY RECKONER FOR THE PARENTS OF THE INITIAL CHAPTER

SESSION: 2022-2023





Dear Parents,

A warm welcome to all of you at the beginning of the new academic session 2022-23 at Scottish High International School. At the onset, we would like to put your mind at ease through this ready reckoner which may be referred for a smooth transition to a formal school.



To ensure that the children settle down smoothly into the school routine, a few points for your perusal:



- You are required to submit the complete stationery duly labelled on the first day of the school i.e. 4th April, 2022.
- ✓ The ID card should be worn by the child daily. A clean handkerchief/ small hand napkin is to be pinned onto the child's uniform. Parents of children in Nursery and Kindergarten are required to deposit a **spare set of clothes and underwear** in a labelled bag with the Home Room Tutor(s) within the first 2 days of school. These will be returned at the end of the session.
- ✓ Girls with long hair to tie them in ponytails or plaits (for hair longer than shoulders using black bands and those with short hair to wear black clips/ black nylon hair bands). For Sikh boys-grey patkas are to be worn in summers and maroon in winters.

✓ Gate no. 3 to be used by the parents and children of the Initial Wing for arrival and dispersal.

- ✓ For the first few days, parents can drop the child into the class room. Thereafter, children will enter the building on their own and teachers will be around to guide them.
- ✓ Dispersal for walkers will take place from the class itself for the first few days, once the bus route children have been dispersed. Parents to come in by 12:50 pm and enter from the Initial's reception to go to the class of their child and disperse from the side door entrance.

- ✓ The child has to be in school by **7:50 am**. Kindly ensure timely arrival of your ward at school.
- Teachers will be present at the earmarked locations/ classrooms to receive and see off children during the arrival and dispersal timings.
- ✓ Authorization card is mandatory in order to collect the students. The person coming to pick up the child must carry the authorization card. In case the person is not carrying the card, he/she would be directed to the Initial School Reception to get an authorization slip.
- ✓ The E.R.I.C. is the main mode of communication between the school and the parent. Kindly check it daily and acknowledge the Home Room Tutors' notes and all the circulars sent by signing in the E.R.I.C. on pages 131-132.
- ✓ Please fill up pages 5, 6, 7, 8 and 31 to 35 of the E.R.I.C. and send a duly completed E.R.I.C. within **first week** of school.
- ✓ We shall be sending you the yearly curriculum within the first week of the new session. Kindly refer to it for a detailed breakup of the syllabus.
- To enhance the bonding between the school and home, our teachers will be coming over to visit you at your homes at the onset of the academic year. We look forward to your welcoming them preferably within the first two months.
- ✓ Our first Parent Teacher Meeting will be on Saturday, 23rd April'22. The time schedule for the same will be sent to you.
